

A Letter from Rabbi Bigman

At our annual meeting in May, we studied a portion from the *Talmud* from tractate *Taanit*, page 7a. It speaks to the benefit of studying Torah with other people rather than alone (see especially the words in bold below):

אמר רב הונא בר רב הונא, Mai Dekhiv: "ברזל בברזל יתד", לומר לך: מה בחרל זה — אחד מחדד את סבירו, אף שני תלמידי חכמים — מחדדין זה את זה בהלכה

The Gemara cites other expositions that deal with *Torah* study. Rabbi Hama, son of Rabbi Hanina, said: What is the meaning of that which is written: "Iron sharpens iron, so a man sharpens the countenance of his friend" (Proverbs 27:17)? **This verse comes to tell you that just as with these iron implements, one sharpens the other when they are rubbed against each other, so too, when Torah scholars study together, they sharpen one another in halakhah.**

אמר רב בר רב חנה: למה נמשל דברי תורה לאש, שנאמר: "הלא כה דברי כאש נאם ה'", לומר לך: מה אש איננו דלק היחיד, אף דברי תורה אין מתקיימים ביחיד

Rabba bar bar Hanina said: Why are matters of *Torah* compared to fire, as it is stated: "Is not My word like fire, says the Lord" (Jeremiah 23:29)? **To tell you: Just as fire does not ignite in a lone stick of wood but in a pile of kindling, so too, matters of Torah are not retained and understood properly by a lone scholar who studies by himself, but by a group of Sages.**

ומיינו דאמר רב יוסף בר חנינה, Mai Dekhiv: "חרב אל הבדים ונאלו", חרב על שנאייהן של תלמידי חכמים שעוסקין בעבד בתורה. ולא עוד אלא שמטפשים, שנאמר: "ונאלו"

And this is what Rabbi Yosei bar Hanina said: What is the meaning of that which is written: "A sword is upon the boasters [*habaddim*], and they shall become fools [*noalu*]" (Jeremiah 50:36)? This verse can be interpreted homiletically: There is a sword upon the enemies of *Torah* scholars, a euphemism for *Torah* scholars themselves, who sit alone [*bad bevad*] and study *Torah*. And not only that, but **those who study by themselves grow foolish from their solitary Torah study**, as it is stated: "And they shall become fools." . . .



A Letter from Rabbi Bigman

אמר רבי נחמן בר יצחק: למה נמשלו דברי תורה כעץ, שנאמר: "עץ חיים היה למפיקים בה", לומר לך: מה עץ קטן מזליק את הגדול, אף תלמידי סכמים קטנים מחדלים את הגדולים.

Rav Nahman bar Yitzhak said: Why are *Torah* matters likened to a tree, as it is stated: "It is a tree of life to them who lay hold upon it" (Proverbs 3:18)? **This verse comes to tell you that just as a small piece of wood can ignite a large piece, so too, minor *Torah* scholars can sharpen great *Torah* scholars and enable them to advance in their studies . . .**

At our annual meeting I commented that studying Jewish texts is best done with others and is one of many opportunities to connect with our Judaism and with each other. At Shaarey Zedek we do so by offering adult education opportunities of different kinds, from beginning to more advanced levels. But there are many other aspects of our lives for which we also need others: saying *Kaddish* (for which a quorum of ten adult Jews is required) as well as celebrating lifecycle events such as baby namings, *B'nei Mitzvah*, Confirmation, religious school graduation, conversion, etc. We also demonstrate our need to connect with others by welcoming our new members during Shaarey Zedek Live! worship with a blessing in front of their new community, their new family at Shaarey Zedek.

When we come together to worship as a community, our worship is enhanced as we join together in song and prayer. When we mourn a loved one or celebrate an important lifecycle event, we need our community. A supportive community makes all the difference.

May our members find this community here at Shaarey Zedek!

Considered a Zen proverb by many and an updated version of Marcus Aurelius by others, the idea of seeing obstacles as opportunities for growth is invaluable.
