A Letter from Rabbi Bigman

Dear Friends,

As you saw in my June 28th e-mail, I have announced my retirement from Congregation Shaarey Zedek, effective June 30, 2027. Since that announcement, I have been asked to share my plans for the years that follow.

For the 2027-2028 fiscal year, Stefan and I will be away from the congregation. While we plan to continue to live in this community, it is appropriate for us to stay away for at least a year so that the new rabbi may develop relationships with you and work with staff and lay leaders to develop their own *minhagim*. The new rabbi's duties, amongst other things, will be to perform all lifecycle ceremonies, lead worship, teach, and represent the congregation in the greater Lansing community. I will not participate in these duties unless requested by the new rabbi.

Right now I have no definitive plans for what happens after June 30, 2027. As that retirement date gets closer, I'm sure I will have more thoughts about how to fill my days, but for now I am focused on working with all of you for the next two years.

It has been a privilege to be part of your lives for the past eighteen years. I look forward to the next two years of learning and worshiping with you and celebrating special occasions and lifecycle ceremonies with you. During these two years I will still be available for funerals, of course, and look forward to my continued work with conversion students and in the community.

SECURITY CORNER

I know that as antisemitic attacks grow more frequent, our fear of being in our synagogue increases, so I want to talk to you about our security.

We are focused on synagogue security every day. For the last two years, we have had at least one armed guard at services, school, and events. When a guard arrives, we brief them on the event, current events, and any concerns brought forward by congregants. I am in frequent touch with Jewish Community Security in Detroit for information and advice. They are able to tell us about known threats, if any. Right now, they advise Jewish institutions to be on alert but there are no specific, known threats at this time.

We continue to be ahead of most congregations in our security measures. In addition to armed guards, we now have security film on our windows and doors to slow down an armed attack. We are currently installing a new camera and building entry system, which may be complete by the time you read this. We will be scheduling sessions to orient congregants to the changes. Please be on the lookout and attend a session. We want all our members to understand the system, and what, if any, role you will need to play.

Part of keeping us secure is keeping information secure. Please do not discuss any of our security measures with outsiders. We may feel these measures are obvious to everyone, but they are not. We do not want to make it easier for attackers to prepare.

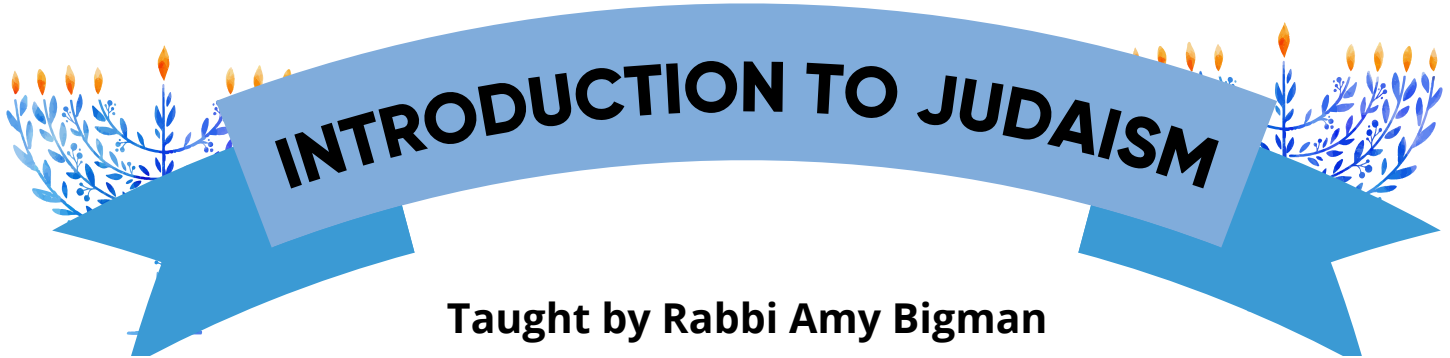
