A Letter from Rabbi Bigman

ENGLISH B'YACHAD

Recently I began volunteering with a program called "English B'Yachad" (English Together) which is a program of the Skilled Volunteers for Israel. This is a program which helps people in Israel improve their English-speaking skills. You do not have to be a teacher nor do you need to know Hebrew to become a mentor. All you need is an hour or two per week in the middle of the day (Eastern Time Zone) to meet with a person in Israel (for whom it will be evening).

This program particularly focuses on Ethiopian Israelis who are going out into the workforce and need to improve their English skills as they interview with companies. For example, the woman I am working with, Sarit, is a native Israeli who comes from an Ethiopian family. Being raised in Israel, she speaks fluent Hebrew, of course, and is also fluent in Amharic, the language of Ethiopia, which is spoken in her home. She also has very good English skills, but is learning to be more fluent by speaking with me. Although students learn English in Israel, it is important for them to converse with native English speakers so that their English is more natural and fluent.

You can meet via Zoom or WhatsApp and just have a conversation! Sarit and I have talked about our family backgrounds, her job search, her friend's upcoming wedding, and much more. I also learned about the city in which she lives, how she helps to take care of her grandmother a few days a week, and the position she is looking to obtain (supply chain technical analyst).

I admit, it was a bit daunting at first, wondering about what in the world I could possibly talk to an Ethiopian-Israeli young woman half my age, but we spoke for about 45 minutes the first time we met! Yes, Sarit sometimes struggles to find the correct words in English, but she speaks well enough that I can understand her. Our goal is for her to be more fluent and more assured of her speaking skills so that she can readily speak with anyone in English.

There is plenty of mentor assistance available on the website and the staff are very responsive to questions you may have. I'd be happy to speak with you, too, if you are interested in learning more. The website is https://www.skillvolunteerisrael.org/
