A Letter from Rabbi Bigman

TO PATTY WARSHAW ON HER TWENTY YEARS OF SERVICE AS CONGREGATION SHAAREY ZEDEK'S ADMINISTRATOR

Dear Patty,

As I write this, it's only been a few weeks since you announced your retirement, but I don't think the reality has sunk in yet -- for me and for all Shaarey Zedek members.

You have been so much more than an administrator; you have been "chief cook and bottle washer" (literally!) and a friend and confidante to staff and congregants alike. You have been Shaarey Zedek's cheerleader and you have done the behind-the-scenes work that we will only fully understand and recognize once you have retired.

You have been our liaison to East Lansing's Faith & Blue Day and you have brought the Parkinson's support group and police canine trainings to our congregation. You are the person that enables us to house two precincts in our building on election days.

You spend countless hours preparing for and then working with the bookkeeper on her monthly visit to the congregation, ensuring that bills and salaries are paid, reimbursements are handled in a timely manner, and financial statements are sent to the board for their monthly meetings.

You move furniture for various programs and you make sure that we are all well fed! (I will definitely miss your mushroom barley soup, pasta salad, *kugel*, and *charoset*.) Your expertise in the kitchen has allowed us to have *Chanukah* dinners, Soup-er *Shabbat* evenings, picnics, and more. Your contributions to Sisterhood's *Pesach seder* are always delicious! Our *Yom Kippur* break-fast is always just what I need after fasting and leading worship all day long.

Throughout the years you have challenged yourself by learning Hebrew and becoming an adult *Bat Mitzvah*. You served as a *Bar Mitzvah* tutor for one student and regularly chanted an *aliyah* or two on *Shabbat* morning and during the High Holy Days. You also learned how to lead *shivah minyanim*.

Your accomplishments are too many to list; your impact on our congregation cannot be overstated. I often note that until the pandemic and my meeting Stefan, you were the person that I saw most in my life. In the office and at worship, you were always there. I am saddened that I won't see you as regularly as I have these past sixteen years that we've worked together, but I am happy for you as you embark upon a new phase of your life. I, along with the entire congregation, take comfort in knowing that you will still be part of our congregation and community.

May you enjoy this new phase of your life and may God grant you many, many more years of good health and happiness!

HIGH HOLY DAYS PARTICIPATION REQUEST

Last year, at the recommendation of the Ritual Committee, the Shaarey Zedek Board passed a resolution changing how participation in High Holy Days worship will occur. Members-in-good-standing are welcome to volunteer for one of the roles listed below. If more people request to participate than there are spots available, the Ritual Committee will make the final decision. All participation will be confirmed in writing. **Our past presidents will continue to be honored during the *Kol Nidrei* service; as in previous years, Rabbi Bigman will continue to personally invite the past presidents to join her on the *bimah* for *Kol Nidrei*.**

Rabbi Bigman will assign *Torah* and *Haftarah* readers. If you would like to learn to read or chant *Torah* or *Haftarah* this year, please contact her at rabbibigman@shaareyzedek.com.

Please contact Ritual Committee Chairperson **David Ely** at david.m.ely@me.com or 712-8444 by July 1st if you would like to participate in this year's High Holy Days. The following roles are open to members-in-good-standing this year:

Erev Rosh HaShanah, Friday, September 15: sit on *bimah* (up to 4 people), light candles, English reading prior to the *Kiddush*, open the Ark for the singing of *Avinu Malkeinu*, open the Ark for the chanting of *Aleinu*

Rosh HaShanah, Saturday, September 16: *hakafah* (carry the *Torah* scroll around the sanctuary before the reading), *aliyot* (5 people or couples), *hagbahah* (lifting the *Torah* scroll), *g'lilah* (dressing the *Torah* scroll)

Rosh HaShanah, Sunday, September 17: *hakafah* (two people to carry the *Torah* scrolls around the sanctuary before and after the reading), *aliyot* (5 people or couples), *hagbahah* (two people to lift the two *Torah* scrolls), *g'lilah* (two people to dress the two *Torah* scrolls)

Kol Nidrei, Sunday, September 24: our current and past presidents will participate in worship this evening

Yom Kippur, Monday, September 25:

Morning Worship: *hakafah* (carry the *Torah* scroll around the sanctuary before the reading), *aliyot* (5 people or couples), *hagbahah* (lifting the *Torah* scroll), *g'lilah* (dressing the *Torah* scroll)

Afternoon (*Minkhah*) Worship: *aliyot* (3 people or couples), *hagbahah* (lifting the *Torah* scroll), *g'lilah* (dressing the *Torah* scroll)

Concluding (*Ne'ilah*) Worship: open the Ark at the conclusion of worship.

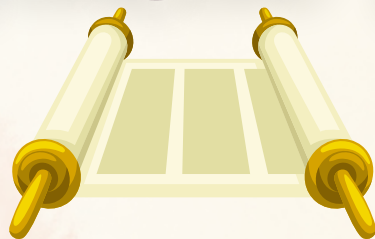
