

A Message from *Menahelet* Margot

Dear Congregation Shaarev Zedek,

I am excited to announce that on December 3rd I was ordained as a rabbi through the Pluralist Rabbinical Seminary (PRS) at a ceremony in Tarrytown, NY. I loved my PRS education and I learned so much in the program. I am looking forward to seeing how my new skills can be used to serve the community and enrich my work as I continue in my role as Director of Congregational Lifelong Learning.

I plan to continue my role (and title) of Menahelet (Director) in my part-time work at Shaarev Zedek. Serving the educational needs of the community and running the religious school is my passion! It was what I was hired to do and I love doing it! It will be okay to address me with the title "rabbi," just as long as we understand that my role at Shaarey Zedek is as the educator, not rabbi of the congregation.

Rabbi Bigman remains the Mara D'atra (the rabbinic authority) of our community. All questions pertaining to Shaarey Zedek and communal ritual, practice, and custom are her exclusive domain. Rabbi Bigman is also the first person to call for all life-cycle events. People will not get to "pick" which rabbi they want for a given life-cycle event. However, with my new skills, I will be happy to pick up some of the rabbi's work in this domain, when she is unavailable, as a service to her and the community. Rabbi Bigman remains the rabbi on the bimah. She can, of course, as she has in the past, call on me to lead a service if she will be out of town or if she is sick. Leading

services, however, will not be one of my central duties. As more possibilities arise, I look forward to figuring out exactly how I can be helpful while

staying in my lane.

We are planning to celebrate as a community in the spring. More details to come in the months to follow!

I am so grateful for Rabbi Bigman's encouragement and support from the moment I first discussed this with her and throughout this journey. I also really appreciate your support and patience

as I went through this process. Thank you so much!





WHAT DOES JUDAISM SAY ABOUT THE ISSUES OF TODAY?

Using the Freehof Institute of Progressive Halakhah's Twelve-Minute Shiur, we will study the lesson with Rabbi Dr. Washofsky (pre-recorded) and then discuss it (live) with Rabbi Bigman.

Rabbi Mark Washofsky, Ph.D., is professor emeritus at the Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion's Cincinnati campus. He has been involved with HUC for over 50 years.

He chaired the Responsa Committee of the Central Conference of American Rabbis from 1996-2017 and has been a sought-after expert in a broad array of Reform responses to Jewish ethical and legal issues. His book, Jewish Living: A Guide to Contemporary Reform Practice, serves as a desk reference for many congregational leaders and professionals. His extensive publications include Reform Responsa for the Twenty-First Century and essays and articles on medieval halakhic literature, the application of legal theory to the study of Jewish law, Jewish bioethics, outreach and conversion, among other topics.

Dr. Washofsky has been a Shaarey Zedek scholar-in-residence twice, most recently in the fall of 2016 to celebrate Rabbi Bigman's 25th anniversary in the rabbinate.
