# A Letter from Rabbi Bigman

## HOW IS FOOTBALL LIKE LIFE?

Super Bowl Sunday is coming up soon! Super Bowl LX will be played on Sunday, February 8 at Levi's Stadium in Santa Clara, California. Sadly, our Detroit Lions will not be playing (yet again!).

About a year ago one of my colleagues posed the following question on the Reform rabbis' Facebook page: "How is football like life?" One colleague noted that "football IS life," referring to the famous quote from the TV show "Ted Lasso." (On "Ted Lasso," which takes place in England, the word "football" refers to what we Americans call soccer.)

A few of my colleagues noted that in (American) football the team has four tries to move the ball ten yards down the field. If the team doesn't get it after the first try, it has three more attempts. ("If at first you don't succeed, try, try again!") If Team A doesn't move the ball ten yards after the fourth time, the ball is turned over to Team B. While Team A's defense is on the field, its offense has the chance to re-group and figure out how to get the job done, how to do things better or more efficiently, when the ball is returned to the offense.

Taking care of our world feels like football: We try to "move the ball down the field," with the hopes of scoring, but we don't always succeed, or we only partially succeed. Our world needs so much repair! How do we move the ball down the field to help our fellow human beings? How do we make *tikkun olam* (repair of the world) come to fruition?

Our friends, co-workers, neighbors, and classmates probably won't tell us when they're in need. Some of them might be struggling to put food on the table or pay the rent or mortgage. How can you look for a job if you're hungry? How can you focus in school if your stomach is growling? In football, as in life, you keep on trying -- and you rely on your teammates to help you reach your goal, whether it's getting a touchdown or field goal in football or getting enough money to pay the bills and feed the family.

We may not be able to fix world hunger, but we CAN help those in our community. And so, just as during the High Holy Days and on *Pesach* I ask you to join me in donating to the Greater Lansing Food Bank and MAZON: A Jewish Response to Hunger\*, this month please help to fix our corner of the world by doing the following:

1. Register for the ***Soup-er Shabbat Dinner*** (please see page 5 for the details)
2. Bring as many **cans of soup** as possible and place them on the dinner tables in the Davis Family Social Hall (to be used as each table's centerpiece)
3. **Volunteer to deliver** the soup to the Greater Lansing Food Bank
4. Join together with our Congregation Kehillat Israel friends for dinner, worship, and an *oneg*, wearing a sweatshirt from your favorite football team and enjoying time with folks from our sister congregation
5. Have fun while doing a *mitzvah*!
